ORDER CONFIRMING CREATION OF RURAL FIRE PREVENTION DISTRICT NO. 3

WHEREAS, at an election held on the 1st day of May, 1999, in that part of Brazos County, State of Texas, described in Exhibit A, there was submitted to the qualified voters the question of whether that territory should be formed into a rural fire prevention district under state law; and

WHEREAS, at the election 259 votes were cast in favor of formation of the district and 149 votes were cast against formation; and


WHEREAS, the formation of the rural fire prevention district received the affirmative vote of the majority of the votes cast at the election as provided by law;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Commissioners Court of Brazos County, State of Texas, finds and orders that the tract described in Exhibit A has been duly and legally formed into a rural fire prevention district (or a portion thereof) under the name of Brazos County Rural Fire Prevention District No. 3, under Article III, Section 48-d, of the Texas Constitution, and has the powers vested by law in the district.





RESOLUTION ON THE CONVERSION OF THE
BRAZOS COUNTY RURAL FIRE PREVENTION DISTRICT NO. 3
INTO
BRAZOS COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 3

Whereas the 78th Texas Legislature, passed S.B. 1021, which bill became law on September 1, 2003, whereby all rural fire prevention districts in the state were automatically converted into emergency services districts effective September 1, 2003; and

Whereas BRAZOS COUNTY RURAL FIRE PREVENTION DISTRICT NO. 3 (the District), acknowledges that pursuant to S.B. 1021, the District – which was in existence prior to September 1, 2003 – has been converted into an emergency services district, to be governed by chapter 775 of the Texas Health and Safety Code; and

Whereas, there are not other emergency services districts located within County numerically designated or known as No. 3,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the District, that, BRAZOS COUNTY RURAL FIRE PREVENTION DISTRICT NO. 3 shall henceforth be known as BRAZOS COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 3.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the District, that, any and all contracts, documents, agreements or other legal obligations made and legally enforceable by or against BRAZOS COUNTY RURAL FIRE PREVENTION DISTRICT NO. 3 prior to September 1, 2003, shall remain in full force and effect.
